# Preparing for the speaking test

1. These note templates will help you plan and practice your speaking test.
2. The diagrams have a three-level structure, but of course you can add more levels and branches in notes that you design yourself.
3. The conversation you have during the test will have a more free and open structure – including the interviewer's reactions, and the respondent's additional information. The respondent should not give short answers that only reply to the question.



# Examples

## Bad Example

Did you go on any school trips?

Yes.

Where did you go?

*Okinawa.*

How long did you stay there?

*Five days.*

## Good Example

Did you go on any school trips?

*Yes, we went to Okinawa for five days?*

Wow! That sounds like a great trip.

*Yes, it was. I learned a lot about history there.*

Really? What exactly did you learn about?

*Mostly we learned about what happened there during WWII. It was pretty horrible, actually, but it was interesting to learn about.*
